Background

NCTCOG has received funding through the State Energy Conservation Office (SECO) to work on energy management and efficiency projects within the North Central Texas region. As part of our scope of work we have provided webinars and technical assistance on a variety of energy management, energy efficiency, and renewable energy topics.

EDDY TREVINO, P.E.

Eddy Trevino is the Director of the Texas State Energy Conservation Office (SECO). Mr. Trevino is a registered Professional Engineer and a Certified Energy Manager with over 30 years of engineering and management experience.

While attending the University of Texas at Austin, Mr. Trevino earned the following degrees: Bachelor of Science in Architectural Engineering (1980), MBA (1986), and a Master of Science in Technology Commercialization (2001).

SECO helps public entities improve working and learning environments through energy efficiency. Programs include technical assistance, education, and loans. SECO provides technical assistance to public entities who have the desire, but not manpower, to improve energy efficiency. This is accomplished using professional engineering services for directed technical assistance and for providing Preliminary Energy Assessments.

In addition, SECO helps K-12 schools improve energy efficiency through the Watt Watchers program. This is a STEM-approved literacy curriculum.

When public entities choose to move forward with energy efficiency capital programs, SECO can provide funding for identified projects through the LoanSTAR revolving loan program. Under Mr. Trevino's management of the LoanSTAR revolving loan program, fund value increased to \$230 million with over 325 loans and no loan defaults.

CRYSTAL KAY PERKINS

Crystal Kay Perkins is a Regional Intergovernmental and External Affairs Specialist for the South Central U.S., in the U.S. Department of Energy's Office of Intergovernmental Affairs. Perkins was most recently a strategy and fundraising consultant for progressive campaigns and organizations. She served as the South Central Regional Finance Director for Biden for President and the Presidential Inaugural Committee. Before joining the Biden campaign, she served as Executive Director of the Texas Democratic Party. She has experience in fundraising and management roles on all levels of government, federal, state and local. She previously held positions at the Democratic Senatorial Campaign Committee (DSCC) and the Democratic Congressional Campaign Committee (DCCC).

She grew up on the south side of San Antonio, TX and graduated from Texas State University.




What size local government or entity do you represent?




How to register with System Award Management (SAM)

- Go to www.SAM.gov

Two-step process –

- Step 1: Get a Unique Entity ID (UEI)
 - Requires some core data
 - Takes 7 to 10 days
- Step 2: Apply for a SAM registration
 - Requires additional core entity data
 - May take up to an additional 2 weeks

Depending on the type of registration you need, categories of information needed to register in SAM.gov may include the following:

- Unique Entity ID (UEI) – assigned in step one of the process;
- Name and Address
- Commercial and Governmental Entity (CAGE) code
- Department of Defense Activity Address Code (DoDAAC)
- Taxpayer Identification Number (TIN) – either EIN or SSN and the name associated with TIN (from the W-2 or W-9)
- General information
- Electronic Funds Transfer (ETF) information (Bank routing number, account number, bank phone and fax number)

Special notes when entering required information into SAM:

- Sam Search Authorization:
- Choose “yes” to authorize non-sensitive information for the entity to be displayed in SAM public search
- Points of Contact (Very Important):
- Administrator will receive updates about the entity registration and must respond (validate) in order to keep registration current.

SAM.GOV – Last thoughts

- Unique Entity ID (UEI) – replaces D & B Duns number – will work to identify entity across governmental applications (SAM.gov and Grants.gov).
- SAM registration must be updated every 365 days to stay active for the entity to be able to receive federal funding.
- This process can take many weeks to complete so start early!
- If you have questions – contact the Federal Service Desk (www.FSD.gov)
- Have a wide range of FAQs available.
- Have an Entity Registration for All Awards: User Reference Guide (Step-by-step guide to requesting a UEI and SAM registration).







Funding Distribution and Implementation

- Distribution and Timelines
 - The BIL is a once in a generation legislative effort to rebuild the country's infrastructure.
 - Unlike spending bills in the past that have focused on short term results, BIL is a long-term investment in our nation and will mean operating on a different timeline.
 - Most programs will operate over a five-to-ten-year timeline to provide states, cities and territories ongoing support they need to deliver these transformative projects for communities.
 - Our measure of success is not the speed at which money gets spent but the long-lasting infrastructure, jobs, and industry created.
 - Still, DOE has continued to roll out funding to states and is on track to roll out around half of the \$60B Congress appropriated to the Agency in FY22

NCTCOG has published a fact sheet explaining the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (IIJA), or the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law (BIL), which was signed into law on November 15, 2021. The law funds federal-aid highways, highway safety, transit and other transportation programs with \$567.5 billion through Fiscal Year 2026. This five-year bill replaced the Fixing America's Surface Transportation Act, or the FAST Act, which expired in 2020 and was extended through FY2021.

Texas is projected to receive \$32.9 billion over five years for highways, transit and other related transportation projects. This new legislation provides Texas with almost \$28 billion for federal-aid highway apportioned programs and \$537 million for bridge replacement and repairs over five years. The legislation authorizes more than a 40% increase over the FAST Act for public transportation. Texas expects to receive \$3.3 billion over five years to improve public transportation options across the state.






